

St David's Hotel takes a bow in top awards

THE St David's Hotel & Spa, Cardiff, has been voted Best Hotel in Wales at the inaugural HotelClub Hotel Awards for the finest properties in Great Britain and Ireland.

The five-star waterfront building was acquired by Principal Hotels earlier this year.

The HotelClub scheme is a "people's choice" arrangement, whereby 10,000 consumer voters nominated more than 22,000 of their favourite properties.
